Our Efforts



Arts Education

- Artists in the Schools Program brings professional artists into local schools in person or virtually to share their expertise with children, offering hands-on experience or interactive presentations.
- Poetry Out Loud Northwest Regional Competition is a national program for high school students sponsored by the National Endowment for the Arts and the Poetry Foundation.



The Arts Fund

- Since 1982, has raised nearly \$7 million for organizations who apply and are allocated funds. In 2023, eight organizations will receive allocations from the Fund.
- Supports arts organizations through a broad-based annual community appeal to businesses, corporations, and individuals.
- Keeps ticket prices affordable and quality events possible
- Subsidizes between 15-25% of the costs of over 200 events annually
- Beer Walk for the Arts is a fundraiser for the Arts Fund.



Public Art

- **St. Joseph Sculpture Walk**, is an important, nationally recognized platform for sculpture while educating and inspiring the Saint Joseph community and its many visitors.
- The **Traffic Box Project** is a public art project to create art on traffic signal boxes.

David H. Morton Memorial Fund for the Arts accepts memorial contributions, bequests, and other deferred gifts to help build an endowment for St. Joseph arts.

Mayor's Awards for the Arts annually recognize artists, volunteers, organizations, and businesses for their contributions to the local arts community.



Advocacy

Local

The Council disseminates information about the arts industry to interested citizens, and the media, and mobilizes its member organizations on local issues of importance to the future of the arts in the St. Joseph area.

State

Active in Missouri Citizens for the Arts, Allied Arts rallies local volunteers to lobby in support of increased funding from the legislature for Missouri arts organizations.

National
