## **WHO**

Following CDC guidelines, registration is limited to students in the St. Joseph community entering grades 3-10.

## **WHAT**

Artscape is a five-day arts camp operated by the Allied Arts Council on the campus of Missouri Western State University in partnership with MWSU. It offers children the opportunity to explore their creative side in the areas of visual arts, theatre, dance and music.

## **WHY**

Artscape is a hands-on experience under the instruction of teaching artists in 6 disciplines. Students who participate in the arts often find they can apply those experiences to other subjects in school. Studies have shown that students who participate in a broad range of arts experiences tend to have better test scores and grades.

## **WHEN**

**Monday August 2 – Friday, August 6, 2021**

**9 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. - 6 classes per day**

## **HEALTH PROTOCOLS**

We will follow health guidelines from the CDC and City of St. Joseph Health Department in the summer of 2021, including cohorting, health screenings, face coverings, social distancing, and frequent handwashing.

## **REFUND POLICY**

Refund requests must be made by July 22, 2021 and will be assessed a \$10 fee. Registration fees will be refunded in full should camp be cancelled prior to the start of camp. If cancelled after camp begins, refunds will be pro-rated at \$40 per day.

## **Class Descriptions**

**All students will take the following six classes:**

### **Beginners Cosplay/Costume Building**

*Instructor: Corey Lonjers*

Time to suit up and bring your imagination to life! In this beginner's course students will learn the basics of costume building to bring out their inner superhero by building one of two foam helmet options. The helmet can then be customized to resemble the costume of their favorite comic book hero or a character of their own design. Caution: Students will use EVA foam, contact cement, cutting tools, and heat guns to create their work. After all, with great power comes great responsibility!

### **Dance, Dance, Dance!**

*Instructor: Caleb Keling*

Enjoy a great workout and learn new dance steps. Each day we'll dance a different style and learn basic moves while experimenting with jazz, modern, ballet, hip hop and a fun Mix-it-Up day on Friday.

### **Drama, Drama, Drama!**

*Instructor: Shaun Agnew*

Engage in a week of dramatic and theatrical games, activities and projects. Students will "produce" small 2-3 person plays and sketches while learning the basics of the theatre world as well as dabble in some theatre improv games. If group singing is permissible by Artscape time, students will have the opportunity to learn and perform choreographed songs from popular youth-friendly musicals.

### **Draw Manga and Comics**

*Instructor: Jessica Mularoni*

Create a portrait in the traditional Japanese manga or traditional comic book style, using stylized proportion and a variety of special effects (gr. 3-5), or create a Manga or Comic book cover using a variety of effects while learning about the Manga and Comic book creation process (gr. 6-10). The focus will be on line quality.

### **Oaxacan Animal Sculptures**

*Instructor: Kayla Hinton*

Create a whimsical creature based on the Oaxacan Wood Carvings. Your "creature" will be built with wood and painted with designs. There will be time for some super salt dough sculpture too!

### **Rainbow Bliss**

*Instructor: Andrea Aeschliman*

Explore rainbows by using the colors and its shape to create spectacular works of art. From painted backgrounds to designs with collage to doodling and drawing, this class will inspire you to create all things rainbow.
