Welcome to the Allied Arts Council's arts and wine fest. The event will feature local visual artists, live music, food vendors, and wines from Missouri wineries set against the backdrop of the Riverwalk next to the Missouri River along the bluffs of St. Joseph, Missouri.

Selection Process

We are looking for regional folk and fine artists to demonstrate and exhibit their art at the festival. We can accept up to 30 artists but to ensure a large variety of artistic styles we may limit the number of artists with similar media.

Marketing

To help insure a profitable event everyone in northwest Missouri will know about the event through our advertising and publicity campaigns. The marketing plan includes media buys with the St. Joseph News Press, KQTV, and Eagle Communications Radio with a heavy digital presence via Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.

Demographics

This is a ticketed event that will attract people who love wine and art! We are limiting tickets to 750 people, however the Riverwalk will remain open to the public giving you the opportunity to sell to bikers and walkers of all ages.

Information

- The entry fee is \$25 for a 10 x 10 booth space plus a \$5 city license fee.
- Artists must provide their own tent, chairs, tables, screens, etc. **NOTE: NO ELECTRICITY ON SITE.**
- Submit 4 digital images that represent the work you will exhibit. Name each image as follows: last name, number 1-4 (example ward1.jpg, ward2.jpg, etc.). Submit images at 300 dpi. Images submitted by accepted artists may be displayed on the web site and used for marketing purposes.
- Notification will be sent on or before September 12, 2022. Invited artists must submit booth fee on or before September 19, 2022.
- **ONLY ORIGINAL WORK WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- Reproductions must be in a clearly marked portfolio.
- Allied Arts Council is not responsible for any loss or damage to displays or exhibited works.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting Missouri sales tax on all sales. Visit <http://dor.mo.gov/faq/business/special.php>.
- No commissions will be charged for sales. One-hundred percent will go to the artist.
- This is an outdoor festival and is held regardless of weather conditions.
- There isn't electricity or water available at the site.
